Thank you for your email of 3 April 2015 requesting the following information:

"Please can I be provided with a copy of the contract that was signed between MOD and CarillionAmey for the NGEC regarding service housing across the UK and NI and any supporting documentation surrounding this.

I also would like to know how much CarillionAmey have been paid to carry out this contract and details of penalty clauses for failing to meet SLAs or having to repair the same fault more than once in a 12 month period."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested falls entirely within the scope of the absolute exemption provided for at section 21 (information reasonably accessible by other means) of the FOIA and has been withheld.

Section 21(1) has been applied to all of the information because it is already in the public domain through Contracts Finder and it is therefore reasonably accessible to you at the link below. Section 21 is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.
