Further to your submission, in which you sought the views of the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA) on the ChartCo chart management system service for the purpose of updating paper chart and nautical publications, and the distribution of Admiralty Notices to Mariners in digital format, using the dedicated 'PassageManager v5', via Internet, email communication or Satellite Broadcast.

On the basis of our meeting at MCA Headquarters and the supplementary information provided, I am pleased to advise you that the MCA recognises your product '**PassageManager v5**' as satisfying the carriage requirement for Notices to Mariners under Regulation 19.2.1.4 of Chapter V of the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) Convention and the corresponding Merchant Shipping (Safety of Navigation) Regulations 2002. Due to the frequency with which updates to this application are released, this compliance letter covers all future **v5** releases of the ChartCo Ltd PassageManager up to the release of **v6**, at which point further compliance assessment(s) will be required.

This recognition is given on the basis that the weekly edition of the Admiralty Notices to Mariners is provided in its entirety (all parts) and in a read-only format that cannot be altered by end-users, and complies with the terms of the UK Hydrographic Office licence, ref. HO 685/101015/04. If UKHO withdraws or suspends their approval dated 24/01/2014, the status of this MCA approval will also be deemed rescinded.
