Thank you for your email of 2 December requesting the following information:

"I would like to request copies of all letters and emails written to Scottish local authorities regarding the closures of military barracks in Scotland announced in November"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found attached but some of the information falls entirely within the scope of the absolute exemptions provided for at section 40 (Personal Data) and etc. Section 40(2) has been applied to some of the information in order to protect personal information as governed by the Data Protection Act 1998. Section 40 is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) I must inform you that the letter regarding Kinloss is not accurate and the site is to remain open for the foreseeable future as stated by the Rt Hon Sir Michael Fallon on 7 November. This announcement can be found at https://hansard.parliament.uk/commons/2016-11-07/debates/6492B615-02BD-4B69-B298-4C49DFF19868/DefenceEstate.

I can also inform you that while the Ministry of Defence has routine engagements with Local Authorities which inform its strategic thinking the only documents specific to the November announcement are those attached to this response.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact us in the first instance at the address above. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed. 
