DWP response

Every person who makes a claim for benefit may be asked by the Department of Work and Pensions to show documents, certificates, information and evidence in connection with that claim. This could include proof of identity, information regarding savings, income and outgoings and so we may ask to see a passport, bank statements, pay and mortgage statements. The Secretary of State has the power to require this evidence and information under the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations 1987, Regulation 7.
