## **Annex B: Impact Assessment**

## **Background on the St Marylebone Bridge School**

1. The St Marylebone Bridge School is a special school which will, when full, have an intake of 84 pupils aged 11–19. It will provide for students with Speech Language and Communication Needs (SLCN). The proposers are an existing mainstream secondary academy for girls with SEN specialism judged outstanding by Ofsted, the St Marylebone Church of England School. The special school, though separate, will be closely affiliated with the St Marylebone Bridge School through some shared governors, staff and some resources. This important link will allow pupils to benefit from the main school's commitment to outstanding and inclusive educational provision, without affecting current pupils' access to learning resources in any way. Through the mainstream school's existing expertise in SEN they will share resources where possible. The affiliation with the main school will offer the possibility for easy and planned integration and enrichment, where meaningful and appropriate.

#### **Admissions**

2. The Admissions Code is not applicable to special free schools. All students admitted to The St Marylebone Bridge School must have a Statement identifying a specific special need for communication and interpersonal skills. Students are likely to have been diagnosed with SLCN.

## Impact on other schools in the area

- 3. As The St Marylebone Bridge School is a special school it does not have a defined catchment area and referrals will be made through its own and surrounding Local Authorities.
- 4. For the purpose of this assessment we have created a proxy catchment area of special schools within a 3 mile radius from the free school. This is because parents would be prepared to travel a greater distance because of the specialist nature of the school.
- 5. Below is a table showing the likely impact of the proposed school on special schools within Westminster. It is our view that because of the size and specialism of the proposed free school, it is expected to have a minimal impact on all special schools

located in Westminster and its neighbouring boroughs.
