Subject:	Caustic burn risks from working with concrete		
Who is affected:	Everyone working with wet concrete		



Details:	An incident has occurred on one of our sites where an operative who was hand finishing concrete in a trench was exposed to the wet alkaline component of the concrete due to allowing it to soak into his PPE trousers. He has suffered significant caustic burns to his lower leg and is currently in hospital receiving treatment which includes skin grafts.	
Action Required:	Ensure that everyone working with wet concrete is aware of the risks of caustic burns from exposure to wet concrete, that the risk is identified and addressed in the safe system of work and that individuals are provided with and use appropriate waterproof PPE. Review the tools that are available to ensure that operatives do not need to maintain awkward postures over extended periods.
