

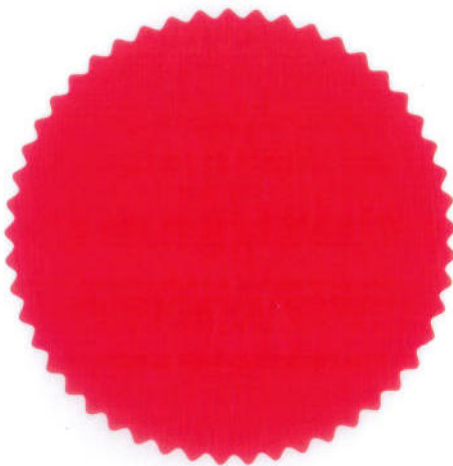


## BRITISH ANTARCTIC TERRITORY

### Postal Rates Notice 2016

(Pursuant to sections 6 and 11 Postal Services Ordinance 1990)

1. In exercise of the power vested in me by sections 6 and 11 of the Postal Services Ordinance 1990 (No.14 of 1990), I hereby determine that with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2016.
  - (a) the postal rates for the Territory shall be as set out in the Schedule to this notice; and
  - (b) all previous Postal Rates Notices shall be revoked.
