- welcome the Secretary-General's decision to send an Envoy, and grateful for Anna Tibaijuka's comprehensive report,
- UK agrees in full with all of Ms Tibaijuka's conclusions and recommendations,
- UK has already provided over US\$2m in humanitarian assistance, will continue to provide humanitarian relief, and will work with the United Nations on a comprehensive response to this crisis,
- but the underlying solution depends on an end to the practices of the GoZ painstakingly described and powerfully condemned by the report and by the SG in his comments on it,
- disturbed that, according to press reports, the forced displacements continue, despite the SG's strong

view that the demolitions must stop immediately,

- GoZ must call an immediate halt to Operation Murambatsvina, and work with the United Nations and other international actors not only to address the human consequences of this Operation but also to reverse the complex causes of Zimbabwe's present plight,
