Information request

Please can you provide me with:

- 1) The annual number of people claiming DWP working age benefits who were non-UK nationals when they first registered for a National Insurance Number for each of the last 5 years, including the last financial year. Please provide a breakdown for non-EEA and EEA nationals if possible.
- 2) The annual number of people claiming DWP working age benefits in London who were non-UK nationals when they first registered for a National Insurance Number for each of the last 5 years, including the last financial year. Please provide a breakdown for non-EEA and EEA nationals if possible.

DWP response

A time series for each of the last 5 years on the number of people claiming DWP working age benefits who were non-UK nationals when they first registered for a National Insurance Number (NINo) is not readily available.

In order to assess whether this information exists would require us to check each individual record which would take the cost of collation above the appropriate limit of £600. The appropriate limit has been specified in regulations and for central Government it is set at £600.

This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 3½ working days in determining whether the Department holds the information, and locating, retrieving and extracting the information. Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act the Department is not obliged to comply with this part of your request and we will not be processing this further.

However the Department recently published an ad-hoc analysis on the number of Non-UK nationals at National Insurance number (NINo) registration claiming DWP working age benefits as at February 2011 which can be accessed via the following link:

The attached document (FOI 2012-3715 Response.xls), created as part of this analysis, shows the number of Non-UK nationals at NINo registration

claiming DWP working age benefits as at February 2011 broken down by World Area, Region and Local Authority.
