Scope	The junction-to-junction road links as defined on the Highways Agency Traffic Information System (HATRIS) database will be segregated into five link types by:
	identifying managed motorway links;
	 identifying all purpose trunk road links;
	 identifying a suitable definition for urban and rural motorway links;
	 identifying congested and uncongested links based on the network stress measure produced by the Agency's Network Performance Model.
Rationale	This provides a segregation of the SRN against which performance can be measured.
Proposed Deliverables (with Associated Completion Dates)	Segregation of the strategic road network into five link types by March 2014 for future performance reporting.
