We have now completed our search for the information you requested in your email of 18 September 2017, in relation to A27 pothole inspections. Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I will answer each of your points in turn:

1. The number of times that this pothole was reported to Highways England over the 12 months prior to the incident?

We are unable to determine the number of times the pothole in question, was reported. Defects are recorded along a particular stretch of road, however the precise location within this stretch of road is hard to log when described by outside sources, e.g. the public, police etc.

However please see attached the result of our safety inspections from August 2016 to 2017. All 5 defects found are highlighted in the spreadsheet labelled 'Pavement Safety Defects.' The approximate section of road examined, is highlighted in the attached map.

2. The date of these reports?

All dates are indicated in each of the spreadsheets attached.

3. The number of inspections of this particular section of carriageway carried out by Highways England and/or their agents over the 12 months prior to the incident?

Inspections took place 19 times, prior to the incident, as indicated in the spreadsheet 'Safety Inspections' between August 2016 and 2017.

4. The date of these inspections, the content of the subsequent condition reports and recommendations, if any, for repairs to the carriageway?







Please see attached our list of 'Safety Inspections', stating what dates the inspections took place and the condition of the road. If a safety defect is found, it is dealt with in accordance with the Asset Maintenance Operation Requirement (AMOR) guidance and timescales.
