Thank you for your request for information about road traffic accidents and collisions in the vicinity of the M53, junction 1 dated 11 August 2017. I have dealt with your request under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I can confirm that we do hold some information regarding incidents on the M53. Under Section 21 of the Act, we are not required to provide information, which is already reasonably accessible to you. The information you requested is available via <http://www.crashmap.co.uk/Search>

The data includes all incidents up to the end of the previous year and will be updated as soon as the latest data is released by the police (usually in August). CrashMaps obtain their incident data from the police, and it is unlikely that they will be able to supply photographic evidence of incidents.
