PROVISION OF REQUESTED INFORMATION

Thank you for your request for information about a live animal import, which APHA received on 5 March. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

“please can your department provide details on the following Dutch transporter: Cab registration BZ RV 20 with trailer registration OL 76 YH, seen entering the UK on Friday 3rd March, 2017.

My knowledge on live imports is minimal and I am unaware of what official paperwork is required for such an import. I am therefore hoping you can provide all the paperwork required for this particular import.

Please see Appendices 1 and 2 for copies of two Intra Trade Animal Health Certificates (ITAHCs) which accompanied this import. Please note: APHA do not hold copies of the original ITAHCs or Journey Logs for these consignments. The ITAHCs provided have been taken from the EU Commission's Trade Control and Expert System (TRACES).

For live animal *imports*, the required paperwork comprises an Importer Notification - received by APHA at least 24 hours in advance of the import - and an ITAHC. The latter is not necessarily held by APHA, but should be accessible via the TRACES system. Additional paperwork, such as Journey Logs, will usually be held by the competent authority that issued the Log.

A WIT32 inspection form may be held on occasion, if a vehicle is inspected at the incoming port. APHA do not inspect every vehicle.

APHA did not receive any Importer Notifications for these consignments. APHA did not carry out a portal check on this vehicle so there is no WIT32 on file for this vehicle.

I am very keen to know:

1. The age of the animals on board
[APHA do not hold this information, as there is no requirement to provide this information on an Intra Trade Animal Health Certificate.](#)
