Below average. 53% A*- C incl. English and maths for predecessor school.	Moderate. The impact on the Academy cannot be assessed as it is still very new. However, in its previous incarnation as Desborough School Holyport was likely to have had a higher impact: the school had attainment below the national average and only a 'satisfactory' Ofsted rating. In the short term there is potential for the Academy to lose pupils, however the secondary school aged population in Windsor & Maidenhead is projected to increase significantly from 2017.

Good	Below average. 51% achieved A* - C including English and maths.	Moderate/Low. It is reasonably close to the preferred site, and, although rated 'good' by Ofsted it has below average results at GCSE. However, compared to Cox Green and Desborough it has a relatively low percentage of surplus places.

Newlands Girls' School	Community School	1,185 pupil capacity. No surplus in 2011/12. Oversubscribed for entry in 2011/2012	Good	Above national average. 75.3% achieved A*- C including English and maths.	Minimal. The school's results are significantly above the national average and it has performed consistently highly over the past few years. It had no surplus places 2011/2012
Dedworth Middle School	Community School	480 pupil capacity. 5% surplus in 2011/2012. Undersubscribed for entry in 2011/2012.	Good	Its KS2 results are just below average. 75% achieved level 4 or above.	Minimal. The school recently had a good Ofsted report and pupils will have the opportunity to feed into the Free School at year 9 when they leave Dedworth.

It should be noted that almost half of the pupils who attend Holyport College will be boarders and so may travel much further than the local authority average. This would dilute the impact on local schools, and also suggest a wider dispersal of pupils from which the Free School might draw.
