In response to your communication of 12 March 2015 requesting the following information:

“copies of the deeds showing the Ministry of Defence (MOD) ownership of Yateley Common, Hawley, Hampshire”

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

Section 21(1) has been applied to this information as it is accessible to you by other means. Section 21 is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
