Re: Freedom of Information Request

I would like each phone call logged with a time stamp. I would also like to see any notes that were attached to these exchanges to set up the meeting. In the case of emails and letters, I would like to see the text of the messages. "

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).
