EU publishes new 2014-2020 Regulations for ESF

The legislation governing the 2014-2020 round of EU structural and investment funds (including the European Social Fund) has been adopted by the European Parliament and Council of the European Union. The regulations were published on 20 December 2013 in the 'Official Journal of the EU'.

The two regulations relating specifically to the European Social Fund are:

The ESF Regulation (Regulation (EU) No 1298/2013 – (p. 256)

The Common Provisions Regulation (Regulation (EU) No 1303/2013 – (p. 320)
