Replacement of guard piles at Sunbury Weir

Our contractor is replacing the weir guard piles at Sunbury Weir because they have come to the end of their useful life.

The work will be taking place on weekdays only, Monday to Friday, between 07:00 and 17:00 from Friday 31 October to Friday 14 November 2014.

A large floating crane pontoon is required to carry out the works. Therefore during the work period the channel will be restricted to a minimum of 20 feet or 6.10 metres wide, Sunbury Old Lock is 19 feet 3 inches or 5.86 metres wide. Sunbury New Lock is currently closed for a refurbishment of the lock chamber.

On weekends and evenings the channel will be open for navigation in the normal way.

Follow any directional signage as well as any instructions given by officers of the Environment Agency and/or the safety boat.

Please navigate slowly and with caution in the area of these works.
