5. NEED Table Creator – publication date: 15 August 2013

The NEED Table Creator provides users with the ability to create bespoke cross tabulations on consumption by property attributes and household characteristics, based on the data available from NEED. Two variables can be selected to be considered at once (e.g. property age and property type), with mean, median or number of observations shown in the table. There is also a choice of fuel (electricity or gas). The tool will be updated with electricity and gas consumption data for 2011, including information for Wales and number of adult occupants.
