Thank you for your request of 17 April 2013 under the Freedom of Information Act (2000). Your exact request was:

"At the House of Lords Select Committee hearing on the Tobacco Products Directive on 13 March the Public Health Minister was passed a letter from former police officers (Roy Ramm and Peter Sheridan) about the Directive. I request a copy of that letter and any subsequent correspondence between the Department of Health and any other person about this letter."

I can confirm that the Department holds information relevant to your request.

A search of the Department's Tobacco Programme team files has identified the following information relevant to this request, which can be found attached:

- 4. Letter dated 3 April 2013 from the DH Tobacco Programme Manager to Mr Evans at Goddard Global.
- 5. Emails between parliamentary staff that support Sub-Committee F of the House of Lords Select Committee on the European Union and DH on 4 April 2013.
- 6. Letter dated 15 April from Mr Sheridan to the DH Tobacco Programme Manager.
