Geographical distribution of users

The numbers of individual users receiving a payment in the period is shown by local authority area, together with totals for England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. As requested by a number of readers, we have shown separate figures for each User Group* as well as the total number of users and overall percentage for each area. We have used information from the 2011 Census in order to provide proportional figures (total number of ILF Users per 10,000 of population). We have also provided a comparison with DWP statistics from August 2013 and Department for Social Development (NI) statistics from November 2013 on (working age) recipients of highest care component of DLA (currently in payment).

As requested by a number of readers, we have included the average four weekly payment and the total payments over the previous quarter. We have also included the percentage of total payments in each area against the total for the country and the ILF as a whole. With effect from June 2014 quarter, the average four weekly payment is calculated using weighted averages that recognise the respective number of users in both Group 1 and Group 2 categories.
