Public Health England Parent Attitudes to Childhood Immunisation Survey

I am writing to let you know that Public Health England (PHE) has commissioned BMG Research to undertake a Survey of Parental Attitudes to Childhood Immunisation. The survey explores the attitudes of parents to childhood immunisation to inform the planning of the childhood immunisation programme. This is the fourth annual survey to be undertaken by BMG Research and the results will build on previous surveys that have tracked parental attitudes over a 25 year period.

BMG Research's experienced researchers will interview around 1,000 parents of children aged 0-2 years of age and 1,000 parents of children aged 3-4 years of age, on an England-wide basis, using face to face computer-assisted interviewing. BMG Research interviewers will be interviewing in randomly selected locations from the week starting on 5 February until 22 April and will be recruiting parents of these age groups through a door-to-door approach.

The survey takes approximately 30 minutes to complete and covers parental experiences, views and knowledge around immunisation and the service offered. The BMG Research interviewer personally conducts the interview with respondents. BMG Research will contact the police in advance in areas where the research is being planned and respondents will be able to contact the local police to verify that the research is bonafide if they wish to do so.
