Reason for special needs marker	Number of records that had the special needs marker against a car practical test booking
Candidate has dyslexia/diabetes	19
Candidate has language issues (bringing an interpreter or needs extra time if instructions need repeating)	96
Candidate is deaf (not profoundly deaf)	3
Candidate is in advanced state of pregnancy	8
Candidate has restricted movement and or uses adapted controls	6
