With permission, Mr Speaker, I would like to make a short Business Statement.

As I announced last week, the Prime Minister will be making a statement in response to the Leveson Report. With your kind permission, Mr Speaker, I expect that statement to be made to the House at 3pm tomorrow, at the conclusion of the backbench debate on Scotland and the Union.

Given the extent of the interest in the Leveson report, I can tell the House, therefore, that the backbench debate that was scheduled on the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Expulsion of Ugandan Asians will now take place at a later date.

I will be setting out the forthcoming Business as usual tomorrow.
