MOD and Armed Forces Reputation Survey Autumn 2011: Topline Findings September 2011

- GfK NOP interviewed a representative sample of the GB population between 26 August and 6 September 2011.
- 1000 adults aged 16+ were interviewed
- In assessing the reliability of this sample size for a survey percentage of 50% on a sample of 1001 the figures are understood to be 95% confident that the true figure (for the population) lies within +/-3.1ppts.
- The Ministry of Defence has conducted surveys of public opinion since 1999. These assist in deciding the Department's communications priorities and help the MOD to track trends over time and measure the overall impact of communications efforts.
- In this poll the Department has changed suppliers and shifted methodology away from a face-to-face survey to a telephone only poll.
- As a result of this methodology change, direct comparisons with polling undertaken prior to Autumn 2011 should not be made.
