Hugh Robertson, Minister for Sport and Tourism has appointed Brian Henning as the UK Sport Board Member, representing Northern Ireland. The appointment will be for a term of four years from 1 December 2012 to 30 November 2016.

He was a member of the Joint Venture Board which delivered Junction One in Antrim. In 2003 and 2004 he was awarded NI property developer of the year.

From 2004 to 2007 he was Chair of the Lisburn City Centre Management.
