## GOVERNMENT-PURCHASED TICKETS

In total, the Government purchased 8,641 tickets for the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games, at a cost of $£ 1,174,421$. This was out of the 10.99 million that were sold in total for the Games. Of these, 4,016 tickets, costing $£ 916,474$ were paid for and distributed by central Government, less than $0.04 \%$ of the total sales.
