L110A2 LMG RESTRICTION ON GALLERY RANGES LIFTED

BACKGROUND

1. LMG practices from 400 m generated unexpected ricochet into the galleries and across to adjacent ranges. The Project Team report indicates that a drop in velocity when the weapon is fired from 400 m might be the cause of such ricochets. LMG practices beyond 300 m on all gallery type ranges have now been prohibited by Reference A.

PREVIOUS RESTRICTIONS LIFTED

- 2. With LMG practices limited to a maximum of 300 m on all gallery type ranges the restrictions imposed in Reference B are now lifted with the exception of the requirement for those in the markers gallery to wear full PPE.
- 3. Range staff and users are to monitor galleries for further backsplash events when LMG is fired and report any such incidents to HQ SASC and OC TAS (RE).

EFFECTIVE DATE

4. The required action is to be taken immediately on receipt of this notice.

DISPOSAL

5. This Range Safety Notice remains in force until the content has been incorporated into Reference C by a change or until it has been cancelled. In either of these eventualities, it can be destroyed.
