**3) What guidance is issued to LGV drivers entering/leaving Bristol MPTC regarding safety, care and consideration to local residents**

We do not and have not issued any guidance to LGV drivers entering or leaving Bristol MPTC about safety, care and consideration to local residents. Therefore, this information is not held. However, the Test Centre Manager has confirmed he would look into this if there was an incident.

I understand, however, that you are due to have a meeting with the test centre manager at Bristol MPTC about residents' concerns on safety, care and consideration to see what we can do to help.

Please note the standard poster we hold is addressed to approved driving instructors. If the issue was about LGV trainers over-using roads we would change the poster to address it to them.
