Thank you for your email dated 24th July 2012 where you requested the following information:

- 1) figures detailing the annual budget allocated to library and information services (or departmental equivalent) for the last 5 years, divided into categories for staff salaries and resources if possible.
- 2) figures of the number of staff employed in library and information service roles for the last 5 years, with separate numbers for holders of CILIP qualifications if possible.
- 3) Job descriptions for all extant roles in departmental library and information services.

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), in which you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you have requested and;
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

I am writing to advise you that some, but not all of the information you have requested is held by this Department.

The Department of Energy and Climate Change was established in 2008. Its policy remit and related staff were transferred from what was then the Department for Business, Enterprise and Regulatory Reform (BERR) and The Department for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra). Library and Information services were provided to DECC by these departments until March 2009 at no additional cost. From April 2009 these services were purchased from other government departments as a shared service, details are provided below.

2009/10

We do not have a breakdown of running costs for 2009/10 as this formed part of a wider shared service provided at an agreed cost under the financial arrangements for setting up the Department. However, we can provide information for setting up the Library and Information Service element of the shared service.

Costs: £18,807.43 Resource: 24.5 staff days

2010/11

Costs: £115,242 Resource: 3.9 staff full time staff

2011/12

Costs: £151,467 Resource: 0.5 staff full time staff

The increase in costs for 2011/12, despite the reduction in staff resources, was due to a recalculation of charges for access to online information services and an increase in the volume of information accessed through these services.

2012/13

Costs and staff resources for the current financial year have yet to be agreed.

We do not hold information about qualifications and job descriptions as DECC does not directly employ the staff providing the shared service.
