# European Funding

- How to choose the right funding project for you
- There are a number of European Funding Programmes
- Interreg 50% (match funding) operate through a Secretariat either in Lille or in Viborg – soon to finish but.....
- Community Action Programme – 75% funding and more flexibility

# European Funding

- Community Action programme in Civil Protection
- Announced by the European Commission through Member States nominated Government Departments – Cabinet Office in UK
- 75% Funding – 25% mainly on staff costs (although this is changing and cash is necessary!!)

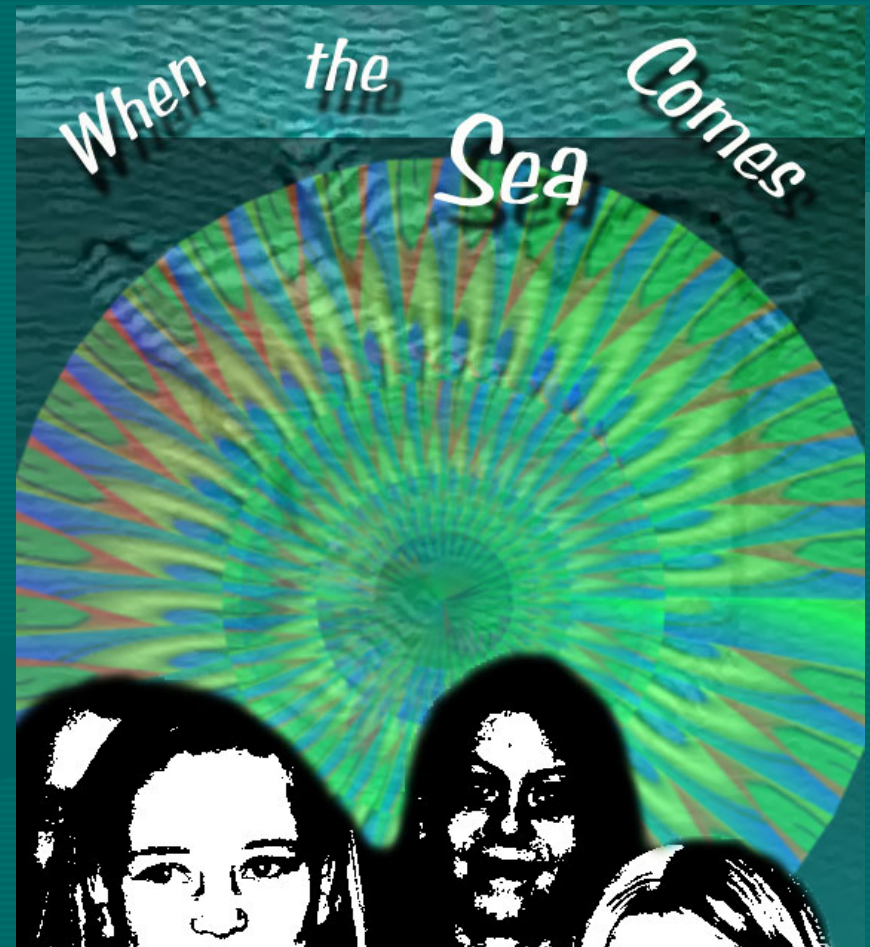
# European Funding
