Since the Decent Homes programme began in 2001, Sandwell Metropolitan Council has received £291,300,000 in ALMO Supported Capital Expenditure (SCE) and £22,739,000 Local Authority Subsidy Capital Expenditure (LASCE) to undertake a Decent Homes investment programme as set out below.
