1) I would like to know what percentage of questions in the theory test are directly based around cyclists; please can I have this information for 2008, 2009 and 2010?

There are 1,120 questions in the car theory test question bank, 40 of these questions are directly based around cyclists. Therefore $3.6 \%$ of questions in the car theory test are directly based around cyclists.

The numbers of questions in the car theory test question bank and those directly based around cyclists have remained the same for the periods you have requested.

Please note that this information is based on questions that specifically mention cyclists. There are, however, other questions in the theory test question bank about vulnerable road users, which although don't mention cyclists directly, would apply or refer to cyclists.
