

**The top ten reasons for people failing a car practical test in Cannock in 2010/11, including the number of serious/dangerous faults incurred against each reason**

In the table below, you can find the top 10 reasons for failing a car practical test at Cannock driving test centre (DTC) in 2010/11. The information provided also includes the number of serious/dangerous faults incurred against each reason.

<b>Top 10 reasons for failing a car practical test at Cannock DTC in 2010/11</b>	<b>Number of dangerous and serious faults incurred</b>
1) Junctions - observation	656
2) Reverse park - control	255
3) Move off - safely	211
4) Move off – control	205
5) Use of speed	193
6) Judgement – meeting	188
7) Mirrors – change direction	185
8) Reverse left – control	161
9) Control – steering	145
10) Response to signs – road markings	120

Please note this information is based on serious and dangerous faults incurred on the car practical test. It does not take into account those candidates that failed the car practical test because they incurred 16 or more driver (also known as minor) faults with no serious or dangerous faults committed.

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
