

Could you please help, I am looking for the names and email addresses of staff in the Information Technology department of DSA. I would be grateful if you could provide me the name and email for the following

- 1) Information technology manager
- 2) Information manager
- 3) Head of information technology
- 4) Information strategy manager
- 5) Geographic information systems (GIS) manager
- 6) Information systems manager

The table below shows the names and email addresses of those staff at head of branch level (or grade seven) that are responsible for information communications technology (ICT) services, ICT strategy and design, and information assurance within DSA.

In the table, I have also quoted against each head of branch which job title they are responsible for from the list you have provided. I should point out, however, that some of the job positions that exist within DSA have different job titles to the ones that you have listed. The names and email addresses of staff in these junior positions is classed as personal data and would not be fair to the individual for this information to be released. This is exempt from release under Section 40 (2) of the FoIA. This exemption in full is attached at Annex B.
