Thank you for your email request of February 26, 2012 for the following information:

"I would like to know the answer to the following request following a letter to me from Ed Davey MP

What is the percentage of recycled paper in the letter headed paper used by the office for the Secretary of State in the Department of Energy and Climate Change with reference to the paper used to write letter ref mc2011/24979"

The Department does not hold information on the type of paper used for each individual piece of correspondence, including the letter written under our reference mc2011/24979. However DECC uses 100% recycled copier paper for all its internal business and external correspondence, save in a very small number of exceptional cases – in such cases the paper used is FSC certified.
