Sensitive Information in Planning Applications

It has come to the Department's attention that some authorities are unclear whether the advice set out in the DCLG letter of 24 May 2007 on sensitive information in planning applications remains in force. The 2007 letter sets out the procedure for following the guidance in paragraphs 24 and 25 of the memorandum to DCLG Circular 02/2006 "Crown Application of the Planning Acts".

I can confirm that this letter is still in force and that the procedures should be followed in the relevant circumstances.
