Proposed Programme of Research and Analysis for 2011-12

The Department is continuing to build its evidence base in core policy areas of housing, planning, localism and decentralisation, economic growth and local economic development, fire and resilience, sustainable buildings and climate change. This year our focus is on evidence and analysis that will help to maximise value for money from <u>all</u> our policies and programmes.

Our new programme of research and analysis will be divided into broad topic areas, reflecting the Department's policy priorities. Alongside externally-commissioned work we will also have a complimentary programme of inhouse analysis.

This year there is a different process for bidding for external research contracts. We will <u>not</u> be seeking *Expressions of Interest for individual projects*. Instead, in accordance with the new transparency agenda, (and to give all organisations the chance to submit a competitive tender for any of the projects), all our projects will be advertised, in open competition, on the Government's new 'Contracts Finder' website.

We expect to publish full details of any projects, and invite bids, in the Autumn. As all invitations to tender will be published on the Contracts Finder website, we recommend that you register as soon as possible.
