

1) The number of car practical tests conducted at Scarborough driving test centre (DTC) in 2011 broken down by gender

3) The greatest number of attempts at the car practical test at Scarborough DTC where the candidate still hasn't passed between 1 April 2004 (when we hold records) and 31 December 2011

The greatest number of attempts a candidate has taken at the car practical test at Scarborough DTC between 1 April 2004 and 31 December 2011 where they still haven't passed is 13. All 13 attempts were taken at Scarborough DTC.

We also hold information on a candidate that has taken 9 attempts at the car theory test between 1 April 2004 and 31 December 2011 and still hasn't passed. Their 9th attempt was taken at Scarborough DTC but not all previous attempts were.

4) The greatest number of attempts at the car theory test at Scarborough theory test centre where the candidate still hasn't passed between September 2004 (when we hold records) and 31 December 2011

The greatest number of attempts a candidate has taken at the car theory test at Scarborough theory test centre between September 2004 and 31 December 2011 where they still haven't passed is nine. All nine attempts were taken at Scarborough theory test centre.

We also hold information on a candidate that has taken 15 attempts at the car theory test between September 2004 and 31 December 2011 and still hasn't passed. Their 15th attempt was taken at Scarborough theory test centre but not all previous attempts were.
