I am working from home and having terrible trouble with remote access so I am forwarding you an email with my latest list attached. You had Rother which both [REDACTED] were unaware of. Tomorrow is another transparency update day so will check your latest list then.

What is the test for £500 Spend data actually going to be? I was under the impression that it was going to be where an LA has provided an LDG 1465 URL pointing to a page with spend data on it – but perhaps there is another definition?

I don't think there is a real definition. I get a lot of the links via the transparency team here and some come from [REDACTED] at the LGA. I make sure that all URLs I receive are loaded into Directgov. Once again there is a real problem with internal communications in councils (but no worse than in DCLG!) and Finance people seem to prefer to talk to us rather than their own web teams.

On the list some councils are highlighted in purple; this means that they are new since last update and others in green. The green ones have supplied holding pages only (look at NE Lincs - it made me chuckle) although I check them regularly to see if they have updated with data. We do not include councils with holding pages only on the DCLG pages although I think it is good practice as far as LDG links go.

Do you want lists for the other transparency services? People are updating some of the links for 828/8.

My colleagues and I welcomed the recent requirements to publish all spends in local government to over £500. However I feel that we must go further to ensure that transparency is at the heart of Local Government across the country. We believe that local residents should have more input into decisions made by Councils and that they can only do so when we have full disclosure and increased sharing of information.

In the spirit of supporting this new era of transparency I request that you consider making on-line disclosure logs of all Freedom of Information requests mandatory. I believe that residents will feel more fully engaged when they are able to open up taxpayer funded organisations to increased scrutiny in an open and accessible way.

The Slough Conservative Group has submitted a motion to Council requesting that Slough Borough Council will do exactly this. We do not know the outcome of this motion as yet, but we hope that the Labour administration is as committed as the Slough Conservatives are to making localism and transparency a cornerstone of local democracy.

I look forward to receiving your response on this matter and I hope my Group's request is given due thought and consideration.
