Royal Armouries – Chair Reappointment

Ed Vaizey, Minister for Culture, Communications and Creative Industries has reappointed Ann Green as Chair of the Royal Armouries for a third term of six months. Her term of appointment will run from 28 April 2011 to 27 October 2011.

As a former Director of the Northern Stock Exchange, Ann was subsequently the Northern England Director of the Industry Society. She held non-executive directorships in engineering, pharmaceutical manufacturing and security businesses.

With wide experience of the public, private and voluntary sectors, Ann is currently serving on the board of Stag Security Services Ltd and, most recently has been appointed Chairman of the Governors at York St John's University. She is Chairman of Hadrian's Wall Heritage Ltd, a private company that she set up in 2006 to improve the visitor experience and help regenerate the Hadrian's Wall corridor from East to West

With an extensive interest in the USA and Canada, Ann is a member of the board of the Frazier International History Museum in Louisville, Kentucky and has been honoured both as a Kentucky Colonel and with the freedom of the city of Louisville.
