Revisions

Fire and Rescue Operational Statistics Bulletin

In accordance with the Department for Communities and Local Government Revisions Policy¹, non-scheduled revisions have been made to figures published in the Fire and Rescue Operational Statistics Bulletin, following the receipt of subsequent information from fire and rescue authorities. The revisions have been made to:

1) Royal Berkshire fire and rescue authority - Retained Duty System strength (24 hour units of cover) as at 31 March 2011 (change of -16)

2) Northamptonshire fire and rescue authority - Retained Duty System strength (24 hour units of cover) as at 31 March 2011 (change of -58)

3) Greater Manchester fire and rescue authority - Retained Duty System strength (24 hour units of cover) as at 31 March 2011 (change of -13)

4) Merseyside fire and rescue authority - Retained Duty System strength (24 hour units of cover) as at 31 March 2012 (change of -144).

These revisions result in very minor changes to the total firefighter strength as at 31 March 2011 and 31 March 2012.
