- The numbers of staff employed by DECC as interns supplied by any company involved in, or connected to, any aspect of the nuclear industry.
- The numbers of staff employed by DECC as interns supplied from any company involved in, or connected to, any aspect of the fossil industry.
- In all cases, we would request that the figures are also provided as a percentage of DECC's total staff numbers.
- If possible we would request that the requested information be provided in electronic format.

Two secondees connected with the fossil fuel industry, approximately 0.1% of DECC's total staffing.

DECC has no secondees supplied by any company involved in, or connected to, any aspect of the nuclear industry

DECC has no interns supplied by any company involved in, or connected to, any aspect of the nuclear industry

DECC has one intern connected with the fossil fuel industry, the organisation is not involved in any direct fossil industry operations but they are involved in subsurface analysis, recording and consultancy, approximately 0.06% of DECC's total staffing.
