To investigate complaints alleging actions by those intelligence services and public authorities who hold powers under the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000 to ascertain whether they have exercised those powers lawfully.					
Notes	The Investigatory Powers Tribunal was established by virtue of section 65 of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000. The Tribunal assumed the jurisdictions previously held by the Interception of Communications Tribunal, the Security Service Tribunal, the Intelligence Services Tribunal and the complaints function of the Commissioner appointed under the Police Act 1997.
