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- Do you think it is possible for new nuclear to be build in UK ?
We believe the Government is putting in place a framework which will make it possible for new nuclear as well as other types of low carbon investment to be built in the UK and we believe new nuclear investment in the UK will be made.

- Could the UK gov done something differently which would have prevented your decision?
The UK Government is putting in place a framework which will make it possible for new nuclear as well as other types of low carbon investment to be built in the UK. Our decision is based on the position of our respective companies and the impact of intervening events since we first formed our Horizon joint venture together and is not a reflection on the work done by the UK Government.
