

I work out of Boston DTC which is on leased land. Under the freedom of information act please can someone let me know when the lease is up for renewal?

The lease for Boston driving test centre is due for renewal on 24th June 2013. The lease is protected under the Landlord and Tenant Act 1954. As such if neither landlord or tenant serve formal prescribed notices to terminate that lease it will continue (as a statutory tenancy) on the same terms as set out in the lease after the 24th June 2013.

Please note that the Minister has recently stated that there will be no further test centre closures unless the DSA can continue to offer a service in the community. The Minister has asked us to consider driving test delivery using an outreach model.
