

1) The oldest person to take their car practical test at Tolworth driving test centre (DTC) from April 2004 to 31 August 2011; I would also like the gender of the candidate

The oldest person to take their practical test at Tolworth DTC was a male aged 82.

2) The greatest number of attempts at the car practical test at Tolworth DTC in the period April 2004 to 31 August 2011; please include the candidate's age and gender, the result of their last test taken and what test centre all previous attempts were taken at

The greatest number of attempts to pass a practical test where all tests were taken at Tolworth DTC is 14. This candidate was male and aged 28 and failed his latest attempt.

Our records also show that a male candidate aged 66 has taken 22 attempts to pass his practical test and his latest attempt was taken at Tolworth DTC. Tests have previously been taken at Pinner, Rugby, Goodmayes, Watford, Barking and Wanstead DTCs. He failed his latest test.

3) The number of car practical tests conducted and the first time pass rate for men and women at Tolworth DTC in the period April 2004 to 31 August 2011
