S4C Authority – Member Reappointment

Ed Vaizey, Minister for Culture, Communications and Creative Industries has reappointed Rheon Tomos as member of the S4C Authority for a second term of 4 years. His term of appointment will run from 20 November 2010 to 19 November 2014.

Along with a being a member of the S4C Authority, Rheon is also currently Chair of the Authority's Audit and Risk Committee, Rheon has extensive financial management experience and is a member of the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy. Rheon is currently a self employed consultant and undertakes financial management, performance assessment and training associated assignments for a range of public sector organisations. In addition to being active in promoting the work of his professional institute he is also the Treasurer of URDD Gobaith Cymru which is a national charity providing a range of opportunities for children and young people throughout Wales

Background

- 1. S4C (Sianel Pedwar Cymru the Welsh Fourth Channel) was established to provide a wide-ranging and high quality television service in Welsh. The S4C Authority is responsible for the provision of S4C's services and ensuring that S4C and S4C Digidol are delivered as public services and also that effective management arrangements, including financial management, are in place in relation to S4C's public and commercial activities.
- 2. The current remuneration for Members of S4C is £9,370 per annum for a nominated 1 day per week
- 3. This reappointments has been made in accordance with the OCPA Code of Practice. Appointments and reappointments are made on merit and political activity plays no part in the appointments process. Rheon has declared that he has not undertaken any politically activity during the last 5 years.
