COUNCIL DECISION 2007/779/EC, EURATOM, ESTABLISHING A COMMUNITY CIVIL PROTECTION MECHANISM (RECAST)

- ■ART 5.5: « Setting up a training programme with a view to ENHANCING THE COORDINATION OF CIVIL PROTECTION ASSISTANCE INTERVENTION...
- Compatibility & Complementarity between intervention teams and other intervention support
- Improve competence of experts»

COUNCIL DECISION 2007/162/EC, EURATOM, ESTABLISHING A CIVIL PROTECTION FINANCIAL INSTRUMENT

■ FACILITATE REINFORCED COOPERATION AND ENHANCE COMMUNITY STATE OF PREPAREDNESS



GENERAL CONCEPT (1)



Integration and simultaneous exercising of various resources, tools, and aspects of the Community Civil Protection Mechanism typically including two levels of coordination: operational coordination (at the Community and National level) and coordination of field operations.

OBJECTIVES:

IMPROVE CIVIL PROTECTION PREPAREDNESS
 TEST THE PROCEDURES OF THE CP MECHANISM

- IN THAT VIEW, THE GOAL OF YOUR PROJECT SHOULD BE TO:
- **EXERCISE THE VARIOUS FUNCTIONS OF EMERGENCY RESPONSE INVOLVING MODULES OR OTHER TEAMS FROM SEVERAL COUNTRIES**

OR/AND

•EXERCISE SPECIFIC DISASTER SCENARIOS THAT CAN TAKE PLACE INSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION (AND OUTSIDE AS WELL IF THEY PRESENT AN INTEREST TO THE EU).



GENERAL CONCEPT (4)

EXPECTED RESULTS

- IMPROVE **THE RESPONSE CAPACITY** OF THE TEAMS TO BE DEPLOYED UNDER THE FRAMEWORK OR THE EU CP MECHANISM.
- IMPROVE AND VERIFY **THE PROCEDURES.** ESTABLISH A **COMMON LANGUAGE** FOR THE COORDINATION OF CIVIL PROTECTION INTERVENTION. REDUCE THE **RESPONSE TIME** IN MAJOR EMERGENCIES
- ENHANCE OPERATIONAL COOPERATION BETWEEN THE CIVILS PROTECTION SERVICES OF THE PARTICIPATING STATES
- SHARE LESSONS LEARNED

Project participant is an entity who takes up some role in the implementation of the project either in the overall project management (project management team) or in the exercise planning (design and development) (exercise planning team). There are four types of project participants

- Sub-contractor(s)

ADMISSIBILITY AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

ADMISSIBILITY

- RESPECT DEADLINE
- USE STANDARD FORMS, NO MISSING ITEMS, ETC

ELIGIBILITY

- CONTEXT AND OBJECTIVES
- EXERCISE SCENARIO

OVERWHELMS THE CAPACITY OF AFFECTED COUNTRY
REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE TO MIC AND ACTIVATION OF MECHANISM
DISPATCHING OF INTERVENTION TEAMS, CP MODULES, TAST
DURATION OF EXERCISE (2+1 DAYS MINIMUM)

- PARTICIPATION: EARLY COMMITMENT OF AT LEAST 2 PARTICIPATING STATES + THE COORDINATING BENEFICIARY
- INVOLVEMENT OF NATIONAL CP AUTHORITIES

Grant Agreement



BETWEEN EC AND THE COORDINATING BENEFICIARY (CO)

- CO WILL MANAGE THE PROJECT IN PARTNERSHIP WITH ASSOCIATED BENEFICIARY(ies) (AB).
- ROLES AND DUTIES ARE PRECISELY DEFINED IN THE GRANT AGREEMENT.
- EC CAN FUND THE PROJECTS UP TO 85 % OF THE TOTAL ESTIMATION.



Coordinating Beneficiary



- THE ONE CONTACT POINT OF THE COMMISSION FOR ALL THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT.
- SHALL REPORT REGULARLY ABOUT THE PROGRESS OF THE PLANNING AND THE IMPLEMENTING OF THE EXERCISE. RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACCOUNTING FOLLOW-UP.
- **EC** IN PERMANENT CONTACT TO HELP, TO ADVISE. THE DESK OFFICER IN CHARGE PARTICIPATES IN THE STEERING GROUP MEETINGS.

SCENARIO TO BE REALISTIC AND ADAPTED TO THE PLACE OF THE EXERCISE

EXPECTED RESULTS

MIC AND NATIONAL POINTS OF CONTACT ARE TO PARTICIPATE AS PLAYER AS THE STARTING POINT OF THE MECHANISM AND IN THEIR NORMAL ROLE

MECHANISM EXPERTS TO BE PART OF ALL EXERCISES AS PLAYERS (MIC TEAM), EVALUATORS, OR VISITORS (OBSERVERS)

EVALUATORS TO BE TASKED WITH ACCURACY UPON INTERNATIONAL COORDINATION ISSUES

LESSONS LEARNED: TO BE USED AND FOLLOWED IN FUTURE EXERCISES
