The Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, the Scottish Ministers and the Welsh Ministers, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections $66(1)(\mathbf{a})$, 68(1) 69(1), 74, 74(A) and 84(1) of the A griculture Act 1970(**b**) and n ow vested in them(**c**), after consultation in accordance with section 84(1) of that Act with such persons or organisations as appear to them to represent the interests concerned, make the following Regulations.

Citation and commencement

- 1. These Regulations—
 - (a) may be cited as the Fertilisers (Amendment) Regulations 2011; and
 - (b) come into force on [] July 2011.

Amendment of the Fertilisers Regulations 1991

2. The Fertilisers Regulations 1991(d) are amended as follows—

- (a) omit regulation 3;
- (b) in the table in Schedule 1, in Group 1 of Section E (secondary nutrient fertilisers), after "Magnesium chloride solution" insert—
